

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT
FOR
THE J. PAUL GETTY TRUST HEALTH AND WELFARE PLAN

This is a summary of the annual report of The J. Paul Getty Trust Welfare Plan, EIN 95-1790021, Plan No. 501, for the period January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

The J. Paul Getty Trust has committed itself to pay certain medical and health care Flexible Spending Account claims incurred under the terms of the plan.

Insurance and Benefits Information

The plan has contracts with UnitedHealthcare of California, Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, Vision Service Plan, and Standard Insurance Company to pay medical, dental, vision, long term disability, life, travel accident and accidental death & dismemberment claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The Plan provides employee assistance benefits as well. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2017 were \$12,758,020.

Because some of the plans may be “experience-rated” contracts, the premium costs are affected by, among other things, the number and size of claims. Of the total insurance premium paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2017, the premiums paid under such “experience-rated” contract were \$445,673 and the total of all benefit claims paid under these experience rated contracts during the plan year was \$279,553.
